# COVER PAGE SUCCESS CRITERIA

Directions: You are to create a “Book Cover” for each unit at the completion of the unit. Imagine that the front is like the front of a book and the back is like the back of a book. The front should catch the “reader’s” attention and the back should give a brief synopsis of what they would learn by reading. The “text” of the book is all of your notes, handouts, writing samples, etc. from class and homework. <b>Content...</b>	<b>Front of Cover must be Creative and include... (10-40 pts.)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Unit title and APUSH key concepts applicable to unit</li><li>• Rank your “Top 10” key vocabulary terms from the unit (#1-10)</li><li>• At least 3 illustrations or computer generated visuals of pictures and captions, timelines, or maps indicative of unit content</li><li>• Illustrative examples of AT LEAST 3 themes from the unit (using text and/ or visuals). Specify the theme in writing and describe HOW your example illustrates the theme.</li><li>• <b>Must be in neat and in color</b></li></ul>
<b>Craftsmanship...</b>	Cover must also be : <b>(10-20 pts.)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Neat and Free of Errors</li><li>• Organized</li><li>• Reflective of the main ideas of the <b>entire</b> unit in a creative way</li></ul>
<b>Summary...</b>	<b>Back of Cover should include: (10-40 pts.)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Summary</i> of the unit in 7-10 sentences</li><li>• Writing piece should be <b>typed or written in NEAT script</b></li><li>• Writing piece should use <b>terms, identifications</b> and <b>events</b> discussed in the chapter (minimum of 10)</li><li>• Terms are to be <b>highlighted</b></li></ul>
