the workers.

What was the

of 1902?

This policy established that European nations were not to intervene in Latin American affairs as an extension of the Monroe Doctrine, which limited the involvement of Europe in the governance of the Western Hemisphere.

This conflict ensued
after the US annexed the
Philippines in the
aftermath of the
Spanish-American War.

What is the Philippine War?

This German war tactic is exemplified in the sinking of the Lusitania.

This was the initial
position of the United
States as WWI broke out.

What is Isolationist/ Neutral?

This message intercepted
by the British led to the US
declaration of war against
Germany.

What was the
Zimmerman
Telegram?

This act resulted in the
conscription of
American men into the
US army.

What is the Selective Services Act?

This plan crafted by President
Wilson to hoped to ensure
peace in the post-war world.

What was the Fourteen Points Speech?

This artistic and literary
movement came out of
New York City and
celebrated black
consciousness.

What is the Harlem Renaissance?

This Tin Pan Alley
composer wrote numerous
famous songs including
“White Christmas,” “God
Bless America,” and
“There’s No Business Like
Show Business.”

Who is Irving Berlin?

This significant series of
arrests and deportations
occurred during the First
Red Scare.

What are the Palmer Raids?

This was the nickname used to describe the migrants that left the states affected by the Dust Bowl for California and major cities throughout the US.

What are Okies?

This group of
veterans protested in
Washington and were,
ultimately, removed
by force.

Who were the Bonus Army?

This philosophy promoted by Herbert Hoover resulted in a laissez-faire approach to addressing the Depression and encouraged independent problem-solving and self-reliance.

What is rugged
individualism?

These three
environmental factors
caused the Dust Bowl.

What is over
farming,
drought, and
windstorms?

This was the name of FDR's wife, who served as a symbol of progress and women's activism.

Who is Eleanor Roosevelt?

This opponent of FDR
advocated for the
redistribution of wealth.

Who is Huey Long?

This law passed under the Second New Deal created a system to provide benefits to retired people, disabled people, and unemployed people.

What is the Social Security Act?

These addresses by FDR to the American public helped restore confidence in the government during the Great Depression.

What were the
fireside chats?

This law legalized
collective bargaining.

What is the Wagner Act?

This successful allied
invasion of France helped
to liberate France from
German control.

What was Operation Overlord/ D-Day?

This battle served as a major turning point in the Pacific Theater, as Americans intercepted messages of a Japanese surprise attack and were able to respond.

What is the Battle of Midway?

This unit of African American pilots are famous for their role in the European Theater bombing Germany.

Who are the Tuskegee Airmen?

German invasion of this
country instigated the
beginning of the war in
Europe.

What is Poland?

This policy of supplying allies
with weapons as a matter of
national security ended
American neutrality in WWII.

What is the Lend- Lease Act?
